VII. By-Law Committee

PROPOSED

Section 1

Each primary member shall be required to provide thirty-five (35) hours of work for the Club each year between December 16th and December 15th of the following year. Each primary member must work fifty percent (50%) of his/her hours (17.5 hours) no later than July 1st. Of these seventeen & a half hours (17.5), four (4) hours must be worked Opening Day Week. Any of the aforementioned hours not worked will be billed on July 1st, at the rate of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per hour. Bills must be paid within 30 days. Exceptions will be handled by the Flag Officers. Hours cannot be carried from one (1) calendar year to the next. The Commodore or elected officers shall decide the nature of work. Hours will be prorated for new members for the first year by dividing the required hours into 12 equal months and applying that number to the remaining months of the calendar year.

Secondary members on a Family (Joint) Membership are not required to work, but a Secondary member may contribute up to 100% of the work hours required by the Primary member. This individual must be at least 18 years of age.
