ARTICLE XIX (Work Detail)

Section 1

Each Primary Member shall be required to provide fifty (50) hours of work for the CLUB each year between December 16th and December 15th, the following year. Each Primary Member must work fifty per cent (50%) of his/her hours (25 hours) no later than July 1st. Of these twenty-five (25) hours, four (4) hours must be worked Opening Day Week. Any of the aforementioned hours not worked will be billed on July 1st, at the rate of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per hour. paid within 30 days. Exceptions will be handled by the Flag Officers. Hours cannot be carried from one (1) calendar year to the next. The Commodore or elected officers shall decide the nature of work. Hours will be prorated for new members for the first year by dividing the required hours into 12 equal months and applying that number to the remaining months of the calendar year.3

Secondary Members on a Family (Joint) Membership are not required to work, but a Secondary Member may contribute up to 100% of the work hours required of the Primary Member. This individual must be at least 18 years of age.3 9

Proposed

Article XIX. Work Detail

Section 1

Each primary member shall be required to provide thirty five (35) hours of work for the Club each year between December 16th and December 15th of the following year. Each Primary Member must work fifty percent (50%) of his/her hours (17.5

hours) no later than July 1st. Of these seventeen & a half hours (17.5), four (4) hours must be worked Opening Day Week. Any of the aforementioned hours not worked will be billed on July 1st, at the rate of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per hour. Bill's must be paid within 30 days. Exceptions will be handled by the Flag Officers. Hours cannot be carried from one (1) calendar year to the next. The Commodore or elected officers shall decide the nature of work. Hours will be prorated for new members for the first year by dividing the required hours into 12 equal months and applying that number to the remaining months of the calendar year.

Secondary Members on a Family (Joint) Membership are not required to work, but a Secondary Member may contribute up to 100% of the work hours required of the Primary Member. This individual must be at least 18 years of age.3 9

Board of Governors ("The Club")

The Board of Governors met on Friday, January 26th and discussed an ongoing issue of the clubhouse being left unsecured. The Board voted and effective immediately, when the building is found unlocked the security footage will be reviewed in order to determine the offender. The disciplinary tier is as follows: 1st offense is a written warning, 2nd offense is a \$25 fine, and 3rd offense is disciplinary action by the Board.

Next board meeting is Friday, Nov 22nd 2019 at 7:00 pm. We will meet at Red Eye Yacht Club. The board meets on the 4th Friday of the month from October to March and April to Sept on Thursday at 7 pm. All Members are welcome to attend these meetings. If you want to address anything at the meeting, please notify the board 7 days ahead of time so it can be put on the agenda.
