

- 1. Fix broken fence behind the handicap parking spot.
- Trim branches over-top dinghy rack and cooler room.
- 3. Old meeting room:
 - 1. Remove drop ceiling panels and replace with new.
 - 2. Paint walls and floors.
 - 3. Move pool table to center and level.
- 4. Clean leaves from gutters.
- 5. Check straps on a/c units for dry rot.
- 6. Weld railing spindles in place around deck.
- 7. Re-attach outdoor speaker near men's room.
- 8. Replace eye sensor on light outside men's room.
- 9. Replace heater in men's room with correct heater that fits the cutout (already have on hand).
- 10. Tighten bolts on both men's commodes to help with rocking.
- 11. Repair frame and rehang mirror in men's room.
- 12. Replace ceiling tiles in men's room, vestibule, upstairs hallway, back hallway, and women's room.
- 13. Repair and repaint stairwell.
- 14. Upstairs ladies room, replace exhaust fan with exhaust fan/light combo.
- 15. Replace light fixture on the upstairs ladies room wall.
- 16. Paint all three (3) bathrooms.
- 17. Paint all exterior/interior doors near men's room.
- 18. Hang fire extinguisher box on wall at top of stairwell.
- 19. Re-attach towel dispenser in downstairs ladies room.
- 20. Replace switch plates in men's room.
- 21. Repair valve leak on bar sink wash station.
- 22. Replace faucet on stand-alone bar sink.
- 23. Touch up paint throughout clubhouse.
- 24. Clean and stock men's room and ladies room.
- 25. Prior to and after VYCA meeting, our General Membership, and other events.

 - 1. Clean and mop the clubhouse.
 - 2. Take out all trash including bathrooms and bar area.
 - 3. Restock bathrooms.
 - 4. Wipe down bar area and bottles.
 - 5. Restock coolers and sodas.
