Currently the decking is secured with one (1) screw through each stringer. To be properly secured each board needs an additional six (6) nails. They should be installed on each side of the existing screws straight down into the stringer. Please let me know if you are interested in this work.

I have been working with DNR the past few weeks trying to get funding approved for a new pump-out system because our current system is not working properly. I am happy to announce that we have received approval and our new system should be operational within a few weeks. DNR will reimburse REYC the entire cost of that new unit once it has been installed and inspected by them.
